Types of Macrophage (MØ) differ based on anatomical location:

- Dust Cells found on the surface of alveoli
- Histiocytes (fixed tissue MØ) found in the medullary sinuses of lymph nodes
- Hofbauer Cells found in the placenta
- Kupffer Cells found in hepatic sinusoids
- Mesangial Cells found in the renal corpuscles
- Microglial Cells found in the CNS (central nervous system)
- Osteoclasts found in the bone
- Splenic MØ found in red pulp
