

Types of Macrophage (MØ) differ based on anatomical location:

- **Dust Cells** – found on the surface of **alveoli**
- **Histiocytes** (fixed tissue MØ) – found in the **medullary sinuses** of lymph nodes
- **Hofbauer Cells** – found in the **placenta**
- **Kupffer Cells** – found in **hepatic sinusoids**
- **Mesangial Cells** – found in the **renal corpuscles**
- **Microglial Cells** – found in the **CNS** (central nervous system)
- **Osteoclasts** – found in the **bone**
- **Splenic MØ** – found in **red pulp**
